DIRECTIONS TO the Cache Creek Nature Preserve:

From Sacramento/Davis/Woodland:

Take Highway 16 (Main Street) from Woodland west 5 miles and continue straight onto County Road 22 as the highway bends left. From CR 22, turn right on County Road 94B. Look for County Road 20 after crossing over Cache Creek and turn left. The entrance to the Nature Preserve is on the left after a half-mile or so.

From Lake and Colusa counties:

Take Hwy 20 to I-5 and head south. Turn south on I-505 and exit at Hwy 16 to head east for approximately 10 miles, then left/north on County Road 94B. Look for County Road 20 after crossing over Cache Creek and turn left. The entrance to the Nature Preserve is on the left after a half-mile or so.

From the Bay Area:

Take I-80 east to I-505 north. Exit 505 at Hwy 16 and head east for approximately 10 miles, then left/north on County Road 94B. Look for County Road 20 after crossing over Cache Creek and turn left. The entrance to the Nature Preserve is on the left after a half-mile or so.
